During the panel, One Earth Co-Founder and Executive Director Justin Winters unveiled the beta version of One Earth's Project Marketplace — a groundbreaking new platform that connects philanthropic capital with on-the-ground efforts that directly contribute to solving the climate crisis. Global Safety Net: a 'Blueprint' To save critical ecosystems and stabilize the climate In September, the groundbreaking scientific publication "A Global Safety Net" was published by *Science Advances*, presenting the first global-scale analysis of land areas requiring protection to solve the twin crises of biodiversity and climate change. The 2-year research effort led by Resolve and One Earth finds that 50.4% of the Earth's land should be protected, upholding indigenous land rights. Mapping data is available through an interactive web application developed in partnership with Google Earth Engine.
