#### Register your key today!

Your new adoorn mailbox comes with 2 keys which allow you access to the storage compartment. These keys are NOT for your mail carrier. To retrieve your mail & deliveries, use the provided keys to open the access door.

Water-Resistant Caulk (Recommended)

WHERE TO MOUNT: The adoorn Wall Mount contains a water resistant design and is intended to be mounted to the side of your house, under an eave or protected area.

CARE & MAINTENANCE: Clean with soap and water. To preserve the color & finish, you can also apply a clear car wax to the exterior. If your adoorn finish ever becomes damaged, exposing the metal, we recommend immediately applying protective paint such as Rust-Oleum to prevent rusting. We recommend applying a lubricant, such as Tri-Flow Lubricant, to the interior of the lock twice per year.

## Consult a contractor if necessary.

Note: We recommend using a water-resistant caulk in all 4 of the screw holes after screwing into the wall to keep moisture out.


#### STEP 1:

Open all doors to the wall mount mailbox. Notice 4 mounting holes. Measure 55"-65" from ground and adjust Wall Mount up & down until you find your preferred height.

Mark your desired height using a pen/pencil. Hold the Wall Mount mailbox at desired height, make sure it's level & mark the 4 holes inside the mailbox (see picture) with a pen/pencil. Remove the Wall Mount Mailbox.







#### **STEP 2:**

Using a 5/32" drill bit (not provided), drill four pilot holes approximately 2 inches deep into the wall material.

If installing on Stucco or masonry, use a masonry drill bit.

If installing on wood, shingled/beveled exterior or vinyl covering wood use standard drill bit.

#### STEP 3:

Attach the mailbox to the wall using the 4 Mounting Screws, each with a washer attached.

Place the washer over the screw. Place the screw through the center of the open Wall Mount mailbox and align with a pilot hole you've drilled.

Use a drill (or screw driver) with Phillips head attachment to screw in mounting screw.

Make sure Wall Mount mailbox is secure against

wall.
